<p> <b>Conditions for Learning</b>  Safety protocols  Parent/Family engagement  Food service  Transportation  Attendance/Engagement  Community services </p> <p style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 20px;"> *Cleaning and disinfection plan following the CDC guidelines will be established and </p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Students temperature taken upon entering bus</li> <li>•Wearing of masks suggested for students age 10 and over</li> <li>•Students able to sit in every seat – encourage only household members sharing seats</li> <li>•Regular bus routes</li> <li>•Students to have temperature taken upon entering school</li> <li>•Wearing of masks suggested for staff and students age 10 and over</li> <li>•Proper handwashing taught and practiced regularly</li> <li>•Students instructed on covering coughs and sneezes using elbow or tissues</li> <li>•Students instructed on proper disposal of phlegm or other unwanted substance in mouth</li> <li>•Students encouraged to use personal water bottles instead of shared drinking fountains</li> <li>•Students encouraged to use the markings demonstrating 6 feet social distancing when waiting in cafeteria line</li> <li>•Disinfectant spray will be in each classroom for use as needed</li> <li>•Toys in ECE and K/1 rooms will be separated into AM &amp; PM uses to be soaked in bleach bath each Tuesday and Friday night</li> <li>•Keyboards and tables in shared learning spaces will be disinfected between each separate cohort/goup</li> <li>•Classrooms will be disinfected during nightly janitorial services</li> <li>•Community visitors will be allowed in the school with temperature and health screening and encouragement to wear a face mask.</li> <li>•Visitors from other locations may be permitted pending COVID-19 testing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Students age 10 and above will be provided a mask when entering the school bus (temperature unable to be taken due to operating temperatures of infrared thermometers)</li> <li>•Students will be spaced every other seat on bus - see attachment</li> <li>•Only household members are able to share seats</li> <li>•Bus routes determined by household size – schedule will be written and provided to all families</li> <li>•All students arriving to school and staff will be screened daily – temp and health check</li> <li>•Students age 10 and above who did not ride the bus and staff will be provided a mask if they do not have one</li> <li>•Handwashing procedures increased with lower elementary following a set schedule of every two hours in addition to regular needs</li> <li>•Continual instruction on sneezing, coughing, and phlegm elimination</li> <li>•Breakfast - ECE – 5th grade will eat in their classroom; MS &amp; HS will eat in gym with 6' spacing between students</li> <li>•Breakfast pickup at gym doors 8:15-9:00</li> <li>•Shared drinking fountains will not be used - students encouraged to bring a water bottle</li> <li>•Students will be grouped by cohort – see attachment - cohorts will be kept to 10 or fewer students</li> <li>•Teachers organize classroom materials to ensure individual use and prohibit sharing between students</li> <li>•In the ECE and elementary classrooms, concentration of learning will be reading, writing, and math</li> <li>•Face shields will be provided for students and teachers when individualized instruction does not allow for the 6 feet social distancing</li> <li>•The Inupiat Language Teacher will rotate into the four classrooms and will support the core instruction with an immersion perspective; MS will have ILT instruction in the MS classroom</li> <li>•Students in first two lunch bus runs will be provided to-go lunches to promote timely transition from AM to PM elementary cohorts</li> <li>•Lunch groups will eat in gym with 6 feet in between place settings (tables with markings to show where students should sit arranged by bus cohort)</li> <li>•Lunch pickup at gym doors 11:15-12:45</li> <li>•Visitors will not be allowed past the entry/reception area.</li> <li>•Meals on Wheels and senior lunches picked up at gym doors</li> <li>•Disinfectant spray will be in each classroom for use as needed</li> <li>•Tables, chairs, and other high touch surfaces will be disinfected as cohorts/groups rotate. (during elementary lunch, periodically throughout MS day, and at end of every HS class</li> <li>•Elementary restrooms cleaned between cohorts</li> <li>•Large restrooms cleaned mid morning and mid afternoon</li> <li>•Toys in ECE and K/1 rooms will be separated into AM &amp; PM uses to be soaked in bleach bath nightly</li> <li>•Area rugs will not be out</li> <li>•Classrooms will be disinfected during nightly janitorial services</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Building is closed to students</li> <li>*Food service provided through delivery and/or pickup - lunches still provided for meals on wheels</li> <li>*No transporting of students</li> <li>*Family and community services canceled</li> <li>*Teachers may be required to work from home</li> </ul>

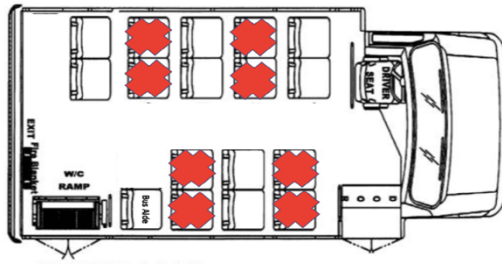

## Medium Risk – Yellow Highlights

### Bus:

- Masks provided
- Hand sanitizing
- Seating



### Arrival at School:

- Health & temperature checks - logged
- Masks provided to non-bus riders

### Classrooms:

- 6' apart
- Masks
- Cohorts – AM/PM & A/B
- No shared drinking fountain – suggest students carry water bottle
- Disinfecting surfaces between cohorts – at end of each HS class

### Food:

#### Breakfast:

- ECE-5<sup>th</sup> grade in classroom
- MS & HS – in gym 6' apart
- PM Cohorts & other – pick up to-go meal 8:15-9:00

#### Lunch:

- ECE-5<sup>th</sup> grade –
  - First two bus cohorts – to-go meals
  - Remaining cohorts – seated by bus cohort 6' apart
  - Parents may choose to pick up students – provided to-go meal

#### MS & HS –

- Option to go home for lunch
- Seated in gym 6' apart
- MS & HS cohort not in session – pick up to-go meal 11:15-12:45
